

Colonel By Secondary School Student-Athlete Code of Behaviour

As athletes at Colonel By, students must understand that playing interscholastic sports and representing the school is a privilege, not a right. As such, student-athletes must abide by the following expectations:

1. As a representative of the school, student-athletes must meet the CB Expectations and Responsibilities (found in your agenda) and must demonstrate Cougar Character. This applies in both roles as a student and as an athlete. If this requirement is not met, eligibility for a major athletic award or athletic letter will be revoked.
2. A player's first obligation at CB is that of a student. The student-athlete must be listed present and attend classes for at least 50% of the school day to play in a game that day. Attendance reports are sent daily to the coaches. If caught skipping, the student-athlete will sit out at least 1/2 a game. Skipping a class on game day means zero playing time that day. Additional disciplinary action may be levied by school administration if overall school attendance becomes an issue. This may include removal from this team.
3. Students who are suspended, either from school or from athletics, the day of a game or practice are not permitted to play, practice or be present at the practice or game, whether it is at home or away.
4. By signing this form, the student-athlete is committing his/herself to this team. Student-athletes who miss practices or games without informing the coach in advance can expect disciplinary action.
5. If a student-athlete is considering quitting a team during the season, this should be discussed with the coach, the parents and the Athletic Director. If after the discussion, it is recommended that the student-athlete remain with the team, but chooses to quit anyway, the student will not be allowed to play on another school team for the remainder of that season, and the following season (fall, winter & early spring, spring are the seasons).
6. Coaches must be treated with respect and dignity. Referees, minor officials, opposing players and coaches and fans are to be treated with the same respect.
7. If you are in disagreement with the actions and/or decisions of a coach or team member, you should discuss the matter with your coach. You may consult the Athletic Director at any time.
8. CB, as a member school of the NCSSAA and OFSAA, will follow the constitution and by-laws of these associations.
9. Unless otherwise specified, failure to abide by the expectations listed above may result in disciplinary action up to and including the loss of playing privileges for that team. If deemed necessary, the Athletic Director and Administration may consider the removal of an athlete from all school teams.
10. The student-athlete is personally responsible for any school equipment / uniform this is lent to her/him. A deposit will be collected and will be cashed if said equipment is not returned within one week of season's end. A service charge will be levied should a cashed cheque need to be refunded.
