**All paper and cardboard
must be clean**

Acceptable

- Newspaper and flyers
- Magazines and catalogues
- Corrugated cardboard
- Telephone books
- Cereal and cracker boxes (liners removed)
- Shoe and laundry detergent boxes
- Fine paper such as writing paper, computer paper, paper pads, advertising mail
- Hard and soft cover books
- Paper egg cartons, toilet paper and paper towel rolls
- Paper gift wrap, greeting cards
- Clean paper shopping bags or paper packaging
- Frozen dinner boxes

Not Acceptable



**Place these items in your
regular garbage**

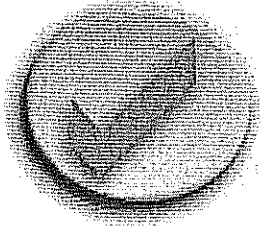
- Waxed paper
- Cereal and cracker box liners, chip and cookie bags and canisters
- Chocolate bar and candy wrappings
- Wooden clementine and orange crates
- Foil wrapping paper, bows, ribbons
- Plastic of any kind
- Paper and cardboard lined with foil
- Fast food drink cups
- Tissues

The following organic waste materials will be accepted in the green bin:

- soiled paper products
- soiled tissues
- food-soiled pizza boxes

What Goes In Your Blue Box (Glass/Metal/Plastic)

Acceptable



Glass

- Bottles and jars

Metal

- Metal cans
- Soft drink cans
- Aluminum containers
- Clean foil
- Empty paint cans with lids removed
- Aerosol cans (empty hairspray, paint, whipping cream)
- Spiral-wound canisters with metal ends (frozen concentrate cans, potato chip tube)

Plastic

- Plastic bottles, jars and jugs
- Tubs and tub lids (yogurt, sour cream, hand cleaner, margarine containers)

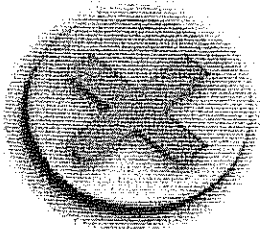
Cartons

- Milk and juice cartons

TC Tetra Pak

- Drink boxes
- Soup boxes
- Milk boxes

Not Acceptable



Place these items in
your regular garbage

Glass

- Ceramics such as dishes, cups and pottery
- Other glass such as drinking glasses, window glass, light bulbs, and mirrors
- Fluorescent light bulbs

Metal

- Food contaminated foil
- Metal clothes hangers
- Scrap metal
- Chip bags

Plastic

- Styrofoam containers
- Styrofoam packaging
- All plastic bags
- Bakery and produce plastics such as strawberry or cake containers
- Hard plastics such as dishes, cups, toys, make-up jars, plastic buckets, laundry baskets
